What a fantastic Christmas of ministry we had in inner-city Durham. Seventy three children at Hoover Road received gifts and stockings and most importantly the Gospel.

Kevin just returned from an amazing Missions trip to Jamaica, over 3,200 received Christ. He was busy 16 hours a day dressed as Dr Irvin D Clown. He went into 20 schools, 4 neighborhoods, and 6 churches giving the Gospel. He also did two training seminars in children's ministry.

The first week he went into St. Elizabeth, Clarendon, Old Harbor, and Little Bay townships, without a Team. Half way through the first week, Irvin was to go to 3 schools and 2 of them did not work out. So Kevin got Pastor Lee to ask the principal to recommend another school to go to and the door opened to a school with 400

children. Kevin asked that principal where else he could go. The

recommended school opened their doors to Kevin, it had 690 students. The response was overwhelming each time. The children are told to not just pray but to give their whole lives to Jesus and continue in relationship with Him, asking Jesus to help them be more like Him each day. The second

week of ministry was in Westmorland area where he joined up with the "Jamaica for Jesus" team led by Rev. Tom Lantz and "Jamaica Dave" Brown. Pastor Shane Whitacre and his family along with Jamaica Dave and Richie dressed as clowns. They presented the Gospel in schools in the morning. Then in the afternoon they went witnessing on the streets and inviting people to the night service.

One afternoon Irvin gave the Gospel to a group of 7 adults on the

street and one guy named Tony, gave his life to Jesus. As Dr. Irvin D Clown went door to door inviting people to come to the evening service, he met Mrs Cornilia. After praying for her She said the pain left both knees and her hand. Praise God!!







Quite a large number came to the night meetings for the adults, teens and children. The room was packed out at Minister Stacey Brown's church in Delveland. The people responded with excitement as the Holy Spirit moved and 6 adults and 30 children ask Jesus into their lives.

At The Rock Church in a town called Retirement, after Irvin D. Clown prayed the Lord healed people with leg



problems, back and feet problems. Thank you Jesus! The team went to Peters Field Assembly of God Church and 45 accepted Christ. One of them was a man named Dillard with his two boys who came forward to say he would follow Jesus. Ruddy, another attendee met Pastor Lantz while we went door to door. Pastor told him he wanted to start a motorcycle club. Ruddy let Pastor Lantz drive his motorcycle and then he came to the service that night with his son. He was not ready to commit his life to Christ yet but he was willing to go to church on Sunday. Pastor Shane brought shoes to hand out for the children after each of the 4 night services. The room was packed with people. It was wonderful seeing their eyes light up as they received the shoes as a gift from Jesus.

Now that Kevin is back we will be reaching out to Durham neighborhoods. There is plenty of ministry of to do here in our area and thought out the US.
